Did you know that there are over 214 documented frog species in Australia and over 122 in Queensland. One of the principal frog researchers in Australia is Queensland's Dr Harry Hines who has published over 64 research papers on the subject.

Harry has done extensive frog research on Bribie documenting some of our unique and threatened Wallum Frog species. Harry will talk about his research including some of the findings of his Bribie research.
